WHAT IS THE STUDENT ALUMNI BOARD?

The Student Alumni Board (SAB) is the 25-member Board of Directors for the Student Alumni Association (SAA). The SAB serves Auburn in many capacities. They are chiefly responsible for planning events for SAA members, securing sponsors for the SAA, and working at SAA sponsored events. SAB members also host various Auburn Alumni Association events and assist Alumni Association staff with their programs.

HOW DO I FIND OUT MORE ABOUT THE SAB?

There will be an informational meeting about the SAB and the selection process on Tuesday, October 20, 2009, at 7:00 p.m. at the Auburn Alumni Center. WHO CAN APPLY?

Membership on the Student Alumni Board is open to any member of the Student Alumni Association who will be enrolled at Auburn during the spring and fall semesters of 2010. Members must be dedicated to working on behalf of the students and alumni of Auburn University.

WHAT DOES THE SELECTION PROCESS ENTAIL?

Applications are due by 12 p.m. noon on Monday, November 2, 2009. All applicants must sign up for an interview when they submit their application. Interviews will take place on the following dates: Monday, November 9; Tuesday, November 10; and Wednesday, November 11. All applicants will be asked to sign up for an interview slot by 12:00 p.m. noon on Monday, November 2, 2009. Callouts for those applicants selected to be on the 2009 Student Alumni Board will be held on Thursday, November 12, 2009, at 9:00 p.m. at Cater Hall.

To apply for the Student Alumni Board, complete the following application. Please make sure that all information on the application is complete and accurate. **Five copies of your TYPED application are due to the Auburn Alumni Center by 12pm noon on Monday, November 2, 2009.**
